Musco Lighting Becomes Official Partner of the French Federation of Baseball and Softball (FFBS)

During the **2026 Little League Baseball France Interleague Tournament**, the French Baseball and Softball Federation (FFBS) and **Musco Lighting** officially announced a long-term collaboration.

Under the agreement, **Musco Lighting** becomes an **Official Partner of the FFBS**. The partnership combines Musco's expertise in sports lighting with the Federation's understanding of the needs of clubs, regional organizations, and players.

Its shared goal is to **improve playing conditions** for Baseball, Softball and Baseball5, **support projects** led by clubs and local communities, and **help develop** the next generation of athletes. The FFBS will be able to draw on Musco's expertise in Baseball, Softball and Baseball5, and broader sports facility lighting projects.



A Collaboration Serving Youth, Clubs, and Local Communities

A First Concrete Benefit for Youth Programs

The partnership delivers its first tangible impact during the **2026 Little League Baseball France Interleague Tournament**, held August 21-23 in La Guerche-de-Bretagne and Vitré.

Through conditions created by the partnership, the FFBS can **cover participation fees for the leagues involved as well as officiating expenses for the event**.

This reduces the cost for leagues participating in one of the federation's flagship youth events. Over three days, the Interleague Tournament brings together young athletes from across France for competition, teamwork, and representation of their regional leagues.

By making the Interleague Tournament one of the first outcomes of the partnership, the FFBS and Musco place youth development and improved playing conditions at the center of their work together.

For many clubs, field access and available scheduling windows directly affect their ability to welcome more participants, expand youth programs, organize training sessions, and host competitions.

Lighting can help:

- Extend facility operating hours
- Create additional training time slots
- Support evening games and events
- Maximize use of existing facilities
- Improve training and competition conditions

Through this partnership, the FFBS aims to facilitate discussions between **Musco Lighting** and clubs, regional leagues, departmental committees, and local governments interested in sports lighting projects.

The goal is to combine Musco's technical expertise with the Federation's understanding of Baseball, Softball and Baseball5 needs in order to **develop solutions** tailored to the realities of each facility and community.

The official announcement during the **2026 Little League Baseball France Interleague Tournament** brings together **Didier Seminet, President of the FFBS, Alexandre Walraevens, Sales Manager of Musco Lighting France**, and **representatives of local governments** attending the event.

It marks the beginning of a collaborative effort focused on three priorities: youth, infrastructure, and support for local communities.
